

**CD101 Child Growth and Development (3 units)**

The developmental theories from the prenatal stage through adolescence with a particular emphasis placed on the processes through which the normal human being reaches physical, mental, social and emotional maturity.

**CD201 Practicum in Child Development I (3 units)**

The first semester of field experience in a child development center under the supervision of a center staff, supplemented by the coordinator of student teaching. The student is exposed to an overall view of the teaching situation.

**CD202 Practicum in Child Development II (3 units)**

The second semester of field experience in a child development center under the supervision of a center staff, supplemented by the coordinator of student teaching. The student is exposed to an overall view of the teaching situation.

**CD203 Child in a Multicultural Society (3 units)**

Understanding of various cultural backgrounds, their implications and applications for teaching young children. Curriculum planning and field trips are required.
