

Undergraduate and Graduate Retention-Related Data Summary

2024–2025

The tables below combine the available graduate data with the official undergraduate annual retention-rate figures for the 2024 and 2025 reports.

1. Graduate Retention-Related Data

Calculations: 2024 = $190 + (190 + 23) = 89.20\%$ | 2025 = $180 + (180 + 30) = 85.71\%$

2. Undergraduate Annual Retention Rate

Measure	2024 Report	2025 Report
Eligible new undergraduate students in the applicable cohort	16	5
Students from that cohort who graduated or re-enrolled	8	3
Annual Retention Rate	50.00%	60.00%

Calculations: 2024 = $8 + 16 = 50.00\%$ | 2025 = $3 + 5 = 60.00\%$

3. Notes

Measure distinction: The undergraduate percentages are official cohort retention rates. The graduate percentages are returning-student proportions and should not be treated as official cohort retention rates without cohort-level matching.

2025 graduate correction: Using 180 re-enrolled and 30 new students gives 85.71%, not 90.00%.

Reconciliation: New plus re-enrolled graduate students total 213 in 2024 versus a headcount of 220, and 210 in 2025 versus a headcount of 261. These differences should be reconciled before official submission.

Undergraduate trend: The official rate increased from 50.00% to 60.00%, a gain of 10 percentage points.
